MINUTES

Friday, February 10, 2012

The emergency telephonic meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m. by Dr. Robert Ferrell, President of the Board. The roll was called and all Board members were present except Dr. Brent Lindbloom. There was a quorum, and Dr. Ferrell appointed Ms. Giedd to preside over the meeting.

Mr. William Golden presented the facts in this case and the staff recommendation that the Board find that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively required emergency action to summarily suspend the physician assistant license issued to June Torrence-Heinz.

Dr. Carlson stated that Dr. Harvey Hart, the supervising physician, should be notified that Ms. Torrence-Heinz must cease practice due to the summary suspension of her license.

A motion by Mr. Christenson to approve the order of summary suspension of the physician assistant license issued to June Torrence-Heinz, was seconded by Dr. Carlson. The vote was unanimous with the roll call as follows:
